## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. All vehicles must remain within the designated Ute Muster area – **NO EXCEPTIONS**
  2. No dogs allowed on showgrounds without a Gawler Show Permit.
  3. Vehicles must not be running while displayed.
  4. Sound systems are not permitted to be used, unless under the Judges instructions.
  5. BYO Alcohol is **STRICTLY** prohibited (all utes will be checked).
  6. “Chick Utes” must be registered in the name of the entrant (proof may be required).
  7. No camping on showgrounds.
  8. Best B ‘n’ S Ute must have been to a B ‘n’ S
  9. Bunting type flags count as one flag
  10. Stickers need to be well-kept, and legible
  11. Stickers do not qualify if: more than 3x the same one, kid fun pack stickers, badly damaged or illegible.

## VEHICLE MOVEMENT ONSITE:

- Vehicle access strictly between 7am and 8.00am via gate 8.
  - Vehicles parked onsite must display a vehicle car park pass.
  - **All drivers onsite must adhere to 10km speed limit/walking pace or lower if advised by Gawler Show event staff.**
  - All vehicles participating in the Ute muster must exit through gate 1 following the parade.
  - Any vehicle not participating in the parade will be directed to exit the showgrounds strictly after 5pm through gate 8.
