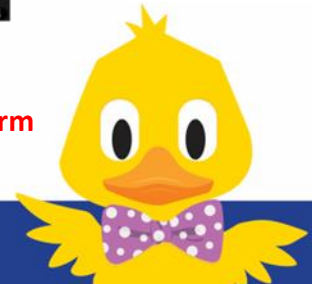

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## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. Each Exhibit is to be entered in one class only
2. **MAXIMUM 3 ENTRIES PER PERSON PER CLASS**
3. No late entries will be accepted.
4. Exhibits incorrectly entered may be transferred by Convener/Steward to a suitable class before judging.
5. All reasonable care of Exhibits will be taken, however no responsibility will be accepted for loss or damage.
6. All exhibits **MUST** be bonafide works of the exhibitor which have not previously been shown at the Gawler Show.
7. Other artists' work **MUST NOT** be copied.
8. Every article to have exhibit number attached.
9. **EXHIBIT LABELS FRAMED ARTICLES** - Tie ribbon or tape to back of frame making sure exhibit label hangs below bottom edge of frame (to be visible from the front of exhibit).
10. **OPEN:** Work must be suitably and safely framed for hanging with a taut wire 6mm (1 third) from top
11. **JUNIOR:** Work classes should be suitably mounted
12. **SCHOOL GROUPS:** Entries to be mounted – 4 on an A2 sheet
  - Student's name, year level and school to be placed on back of painting
  - Teacher's Purchase a School Membership for free Student Entries

## EXHIBIT DELIVERY:

All exhibits **MUST** be delivered to the exhibition hall as follows:

- Thursday 22 between 3-6pm
- Friday 23 between 8-10am
- Entry Confirmation Form **MUST** be produced.

## EXHIBIT COLLECTION:

- Exhibitors **MUST** produce their copy of the entry confirmation form to the Convenor/Steward on arrival at the exhibition hall for the collection of exhibits and prizes on Monday 26 August between 8am – 10am and 3.30pm – 6.00pm.
- Sponsored Prize Money will be paid via EFT within 14 days.
- Exhibits and prizes will not be released for collection without the Entry Confirmation Form being produced.
- Entries not collected within 14 days of the show will be disposed of unless alternative arrangements have been made.

## HIGHEST AGGREGATE

- Points are allocated as follows:
- First – 5 points | Second – 3 points | Third – 1 point
- Champion prizes do not count.
- In the event of a tie for highest points, the Exhibitor who gains the most first prizes will be declared the winner.
