CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- 1. PIC must be supplied.
- 2. Handlers to remain in attendance at all times
- 3. Schools MUST adhere to all biosecurity rules and ensure that goats are penned in their allotted area and must not encroach on other school areas.
- 4. Goats are to be penned by 8.15am
- 5. Schools are responsible to ensure that their pens are cleaned out after the show. Schools must provide their own brooms, shovels, rakes etc. The Gawler Show will provide the waste bin.
- 6. Please state name and date of birth of animal on the entry form. Age of Animal is to be calculated to date of Show.
- 7. Name and date of birth of nominated handler to be provided.
- 8. All Goats to be bona-fide property of School exhibitors and entered under registered name of the animal.

VEHICLE MOVEMENT ONSITE:

- Vehicle access Sunday 25 August strictly between 7.00am and 8.00am via gate 7, unless alternative instructions have been received.
- All vehicles will be directed to exit the showgrounds strictly after 5.00pm through gate 9.
- Offsite vehicles will not be permitted to re-enter the grounds until after 5.00pm.
- Vehicles parked onsite must display a vehicle car park pass.
- All drivers onsite must adhere to 10km speed limit/walking pace or lower if advised by Gawler Show event staff.
