CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. All entries must be made using private equipment by an amateur brewer - NO commercial entries will be accepted.
2. Minimum requirement of two 750ml bottles for each entry (or three 330ml bottles/cans).
3. Every article to have exhibit number visible for judging.
4. The same beer cannot be entered more than once.
5. All reasonable care of Exhibits will be taken; however no responsibility will be accepted for loss or damage.

EXHIBIT DELIVERY:

- Exhibits to be delivered to the Gawler Show Office on or before close of business (3pm), Friday 8 August 2025

EXHIBIT COLLECTION:

- Exhibitors MUST produce their copy of the entry confirmation form to the Convenor/Steward on arrival at the exhibition hall for the collection of exhibits and prizes on the Monday after the Show between 8am – 10am and 3.00 – 7.00pm.
- Exhibits and prizes will not be released for collection without the Entry Confirmation Form being produced.
- Sponsored Prize Money/vouchers/gifts will be issued upon collection of Exhibits.
- Entries not collected within 14 days of the show will be disposed of unless alternative arrangements have been made.

JUDGING:

- All entries will be pre-judged prior to the Gawler Show.
- Please specify if beer has been brewed from a kit malt extract, is a partial, or all grain mash on entry form.
- All entries are scored by a blind judging

Class	Description
2000	Lagers – including Pilsener, Australian, Continental, Bock & American
2001	Pale Ale - including APA's & IPA's, Mild & Australian
2002	British/ Irish/ Scottish Ales - including English Bitters, Irish Red & Strong Ales (including Barleywines)
2003	Dark Ales - including American Amber, Brown & Porters
2004	European Ales – including Wheat, Belgian, European Sours & Saisons
2005	Stout - including Dry, Sweet, Irish, Australian, Imperial & Foreign
2006	Specialty Beers – including Spiced, Chilli, Herb, Fruit, Vegetable, Smoked, (Base style must be noted on entry form, ie. Dark Lager with Roasted Wattle Seed; Robust Porter with Chilli etc.)
2007	Cider – any variety, variety on label
2008	Alcoholic Ginger Beer
2009	Spirit - any variety, variety on label
