CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- 1. All Exhibitors must be bona fide owners
- 2. All Entrants to be Named and Stud Identification Stated on Entry Form
- 3. All Bulls to be tied in allotted stalls
- 4. Handlers to remain in attendance at all times
- 5. All Cattle must be tagged with an approved NLIS RFID Ear Tag.
- 6. Sponsored Prize Money will be paid via EFT within 14 days
- 7. **ENTRY FRIDAY** All competitors and ALL other persons in the vehicle must have an entry ticket to the Gawler Show) including children under 5 years (free ticket) **entry via Gate 1 ONLY**
- 8. **OVERNIGHT CAMPING** Camping Permit MUST be provided upon request and Car Park Permit must be displayed in car at all times please contact entries@gawlershow.org.au for a Camping Request Form
- 9. All competitors with single vehicles (no trailers) **must have their vehicles offsite** prior to 7.00am Saturday morning via Gate 9.
- 10. All competitors will be charged for hay/straw through Showday.
- 11. Competitors must ensure their cattle bays are cleaned and emptied of all contents equipment will be supplied.
- 12. SHOWDAY online entry information PERSON (enter Stud/school name), EXHIBIT (enter name of animal)

VEHICLE MOVEMENT ONSITE:

- 1. Vehicle access Friday 22 August strictly from 4.00pm via Gate 1.
- 2. Vehicle access (Trucks and vehicles with Trailers ONLY) Saturday 24 August strictly between 7.00am and 8.00am via Gate 1, unless alternative instructions have been received. **Strictly no single vehicle access.**
- 3. Livestock leaving Saturday **STRICTLY AFTER 5.00PM** Trucks through Gate 8 ONLY, vehicles and trailers through Gate 9, or as directed by event staff.
- 4. Offsite vehicles (trucks and vehicles with trailers) will not be permitted to re-enter the grounds Saturday until after 5.00pm via Gate 1 ONLY.
- 5. Vehicles parked onsite must display a vehicle car park pass.
- 6. All drivers onsite must adhere to 10km speed limit/walking pace or lower if advised by Gawler Show event staff.

Beef Cattle - HANDLER CLASSES

- Handlers are considered to be novice if they have not competed in Royal Show competitions or have not had considerable experience handling and showing cattle
- Novice handlers are NOT permitted to handle Bulls
