## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. PIC must be supplied.
2. Handlers to remain in attendance at all times
3. Schools **MUST** adhere to all biosecurity rules and ensure that goats are penned in their allotted area and must not encroach on other school areas.
4. Goats are to be penned by 8.15am
5. Schools are responsible to ensure that their pens are cleaned out after the show. Schools must provide their own brooms, shovels, rakes etc. The Gawler Show will provide the waste bin.
6. Please state name and date of birth of animal on the entry form. Age of Animal is to be calculated to date of Show.
7. Name and date of birth of nominated handler to be provided.
8. All Goats to be bona-fide property of School exhibitors and entered under registered name of the animal.

## VEHICLE MOVEMENT ONSITE:

Speed Limit: 10 km/h or walking pace, or slower if directed by staff.

### Drop off:

- STRICTLY between 7:00 AM and 8:00 AM via Gate 8.
- A Livestock Vehicle Pass must be shown to Security at entry.
- Parking Rules - Only vehicles with a **Livestock Vehicle Carparking Pass** can remain parked onsite (this is by negotiation only).
- Vehicles without this pass must exit by 8:15 AM via Gate 9.

### Pick up:

- Vehicles parked onsite – Exit after 5:15 PM, via Gate 9.
- Vehicles parked offsite – may enter from 5:15 PM, entry through Gate 8, exit via Gate 9.
