- 7. Every article to have exhibit number visible for judging.
- 8. NO frames allowed for Diamond Dot Art or Scrapbooking pages
- 9. NO plastic bags for Cardmaking or Papercraft entries.
- 10. All reasonable care of Exhibits will be taken, however no responsibility will be accepted for loss or damage.
- 11. EXHIBIT LABELS Thread ribbon or tape on exhibit label. DO NOT REMOVE BACKING FROM LABEL. Hand stitch or use a small safety pin to firmly attach ribbon or tape to exhibit.
- 12. EXHIBIT LABELS FRAMED ARTICLES Tie ribbon or tape to back of frame making sure Exhibit label hangs below bottom edge of frame (to be visible from the front of exhibit).
