## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. Each Exhibit to be entered in one class only.
2. **MAXIMUM 3 entries per person per class**
3. No late entries will be accepted.
4. Every article to have Exhibit Label securely attached.
5. **ALL EXHIBITS MUST BE GROWN OR PRODUCED BY THE EXHIBITOR**
6. Any distinguishing marks on Exhibits will disqualify entry
7. An exhibit which in the opinion of the Convener has been entered in the incorrect Section/Class will be transferred to the correct Section/Class.
8. Exhibits which have won 1st prize in a previous Gawler show will be disqualified.
9. No exhibit to be on coat hanger.
10. Every article to have exhibit number attached.
11. All reasonable care of Exhibits will be taken, however no responsibility will be accepted for loss or damage
12. Sponsored Prize money will be paid via EFT within 14 days

## EXHIBIT DELIVERY:

All exhibits MUST be delivered to the exhibition hall as follows:

- Thursday 21 between 3-7pm
- Friday 22 between 8-10am
- Entry Confirmation Form MUST be produced.
- **ALL VEHICLES MUST BE OFF-SITE BY 11AM FRIDAY 23 AUGUST.**

## EXHIBIT COLLECTION:

- Exhibitors MUST produce their copy of the entry confirmation form to the Convenor/Steward on arrival at the exhibition hall for the collection of exhibits and prizes on Monday 26 August between 8–10am and 4-7pm.
- Exhibits and prizes will not be released for collection without the Entry Confirmation Form being produced.
- Entries not collected within 14 days of the show will be disposed of unless alternative arrangements have been made.

## HIGHEST AGGREGATE

- Points are allocated as follows:
- First – 5 points | Second – 3 points | Third – 1 point
- Champion prizes do not count.
- In the event of a tie for highest points, the Exhibitor who gains the most first prizes will be declared the winner.

## NORTHERN AGRICULTURAL SOCIETIES ASSOC (NASA) AGGREGATE

The NASA awards a trophy to the Exhibitor whose exhibits gain the highest number of points. Exhibitors who submit entries in at least two different NASA Shows will automatically be eligible for this Aggregate. Points are allocated as follows:

- First – 5 points | Second – 3 points | Third – 1 point
- Champion prizes do not count.
- In the event of a tie for highest points, the Exhibitor who gains the most first prizes will be declared the winner.

## Eggs

All eggs shall be exhibited in uniform containers supplied by the show society. These will be available at the exhibition hall at the time of staging.

**Note:**

- exhibitors must bring their own containers to collect eggs after the show.
- Eggs will be judged on uniformity of size, shape, colour, shell texture and appearance.
- Tinted eggs are any other natural colour shell (pink, pink-brown, green, cream, speckled etc.)
